Cottingham Community Church was established as a new church plant in 2003. We are an informal, bible-based, family church of 35+ adults and children that seeks to be a community of Gods' people reflecting the love and grace of God into the wider community of Cottingham in which we live. Our Sunday morning meetings focus around worship, bible teaching, communion and the family. We try to introduce fresh, creative approaches in our time together that will help us to grow as a community of God's people. We are strongly committed to outreach and work closely with other churches in the village and in the wider area. We have been actively engaged with Hope 2008. We are affiliated with the Ground Level network of churches and actively support Christian community development projects in Kenya, Uganda, NW Africa, Honduras and Central/Eastern India.

Sunday meetings start at 10.30 and tend to finish around 12.00, followed by refreshments and the opportunity to sit and chat together. Once every 4-6 weeks this extends into a shared lunch. There is a prayer meeting 9.45 -10.15 before the Sunday meeting. Children have their own activity time.

Informal midweek meetings take place in the homes of church members on a Wednesday evening and Thursday afternoon.

Sunday meetings take place in the Darby and Joan Hall, Finkle Street, Cottingham (just behind the village 'green' – same road as the Post Office – see the map at the back of this pack).
